Africa New Life asked some of our students in Rwanda what food means to them. Some of their answers surprised us:

“FOOD IS JUMPING!
FOOD IS SMILING BIG!”

One student described his life before Africa New Life as a time of hunger, both physical and spiritual. Poverty means that hunger is a daily reality for most of the children and families we serve.

Children who know hunger understand that food is the difference between **life and death**, but they also notice small things about food that we take for granted. Food gives you focus to learn in school, energy to climb trees and play soccer, and stamina to fetch water and help your family. Without food, none of this is possible. Food is vital to Africa New Life's mission of fighting poverty in Rwanda through education: **students can't learn if they are hungry.**

Africa New Life provides

**MORE THAN 1.5 MILLION
MEALS EACH YEAR**
through its **Food and Care program.**

These meals include:

- Lunches for students attending schools run by Africa New Life
- Meals for students at monthly day camps
- Lunches for those in our vulnerable child tutoring program, daycare, and Africa College of Theology
- Emergency food support for families in crisis

An average meal in Rwanda costs \$0.83, which means \$25 provides food for a child for a month.
