Common Questions:

Team Formation and Commitment: Team size will not exceed 35 people, including team leadership. The team will be selected by January 31, 2016.

Applications: The application process is online. **Upon request** you will be emailed instructions on how to apply by Kerri Thornton. Applications are due by January 15, 2016.

Finances: Please don't let the cost keep you from this trip! There will be plenty of time to raise funds, and it is expected that many team members will raise support in order to go. It is certainly an expensive proposition, but God is faithful to provide.

Team Meetings: At least 3 team meetings will be held between January 2016 and departure in June. Committing to this trip means you are also committing to participate in team preparation as well. Team meetings are mandatory.

Airfare: Airfare will be booked by Africa New Life and you will be consulted before anything is booked. If you have an exception regarding airfare it is important to contact the Africa New Life office. Airfare will be purchased for team members after the official team has been selected.

Accommodation: We will be staying in the capital city of Kigali at ANLM's Mission Guest House.

Immunizations: Rwanda requires a Yellow Fever immunization prior to entering the country. Additionally, it is recommended to take an anti-malarial medication. There are various options for this, and you should discuss which is best with your physician. Most team members will take either Malarone or Doxycycline. Other recommended vaccinations:

- Yellow Fever
- Typhoid
- Tetanus Booster
- Hepatitis A & Hepatitis B
- Meningitis
- Polio Booster

Passports: It is important that you ensure your passport will not expire within 6 months from July 1, 2016. If you need to apply for a new passport – start now, the process can be slow.

Further Details: The day-by-day schedule while in country is subject to the team make-up as well as current ANLM needs in Rwanda. Discussions surrounding day-to-day plans will take place during team meetings. There is a Team Trip Guide that outlines cultural sensitivity, packing lists, and other valuable preparatory information.
