DREAM DAYCARE

2019 - Quarter 1

In November 2018, 28 children graduated the Dream Daycare and 22 were registered into the sponsorship program, all having achieved their learning objectives during the year. In January 2019, we welcomed 30 new children!

Attendance: The daycare is hosting 6 infants, 15 toddlers, and 9 preschoolers in 2019. There are 19 boys and 11 girls. All children are regularly attending.

Health: Gogo reports this class of children is healthier than those in years past, and only one child is notably malnourished. All children are receiving de-worming medicine as well as daily vitamins and a meal.



Learning: 15 children can already recite numbers one through ten. Three children can identify colors and read their ABCs. Gogo reports “80% of the children are very active”. She shares “they are learning to share, say thank you, and be polite” and are settling into the Daycare.

Growth: The Daycare has hired a new volunteer to care for a five month old accepted into the program. The staff are requesting children’s uniforms and sweaters so the children can have clean clothes during their time at the Daycare.
