

"Since I got sponsored last year, a huge door was opened for my education and for my future. I had started school before I got sponsored, but it was always a struggle to pay school fees, and many times I would not have the basic school materials."

For Innocente's mother, who has four children and parents them without the support of a partner, her youngest's ability to attend school consistently thanks to sponsorship is a godsend.

"The fact that my child got sponsored was like a ray of hope in an otherwise dark tunnel. Knowing that my child is getting the education that I never did, and frankly no one else in our family has, is a blessing that I cannot put into words!"

Innocente says that being able to get an education makes her feel she is becoming something great.

"For me, sponsorship is more than I could ever have imagined. It came into our lives and changed so much and gave us the energy to keep going!"

At six years old, Innocente already knows she loves math. Unlike many children her age who want to become teachers, doctors, pilots, or astronauts when they grow up, Innocente wants to become an engineer. And her fledgling dream feels possible because, thanks to Africa New Life beginning work in her community of Huye in 2021, she's now sponsored and attending school.

Broke ground on a Child Development Center in Nyamirama In 2021, we began to see dynamic growth in our educational sponsorship program once again after the previous year's disruptions due to COVID-19. Students in Rwanda were back in school during most of the year, though on a new academic calendar. As life returned to "normal" in the U.S., we saw a record number of students get sponsored for the first time in the fall, including in four new sponsorship communities of Gashora, Huye, Nyamirama, and Nyamagabe. We also reached a new milestone of more than 11,000 total sponsored students from pre-kindergarten through university!

DISCIPLING

In communities where poverty is extensive, food access is limited, and the hardships of everyday life can wear families down in both body and soul, churches have an opportunity to show His love in tangible and breathtaking ways. New Life Bible Churches become cornerstones of hope within each of the communities where we serve; led by passionate, caring, well-trained pastors, these churches serve their neighbors through the spoken gospel, provision of basic necessities, counseling, prayer, and social support.

In year two of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Dream Medical Center Hospital has continued to play a vital role in meeting the urgent health needs of Rwandans in Kigali and beyond. Additionally, Africa New Life's community nurses continue to live out the gospel as they serve as a front line of medical defense for sponsored students and their families. Each week, they are visiting students at their homes, taking children to the hospital for emergency care, helping with prescriptions, teaching mothers about hygiene and nutrition, and even offering counseling where needed.

Repeated COVID-19 lockdowns, a fierce drought in the Kageyo region, a volcanic eruption and subsequent earthquakes in Rubavu: 2021 brought unusually challenging circumstances for many families in Rwanda. Our regular programs continued to serve students, women, and families through school lunches, vocational training, and fresh produce. In addition, Africa New Life came alongside those in need of emergency relief due to food shortages or damaged homes.



122 women and children were supported through Kigali women's development programs


